

Text

Functionality meets art. The result? The Extremis Picnik. The strategic incisions and bends in a single standard aluminium plate provide extraordinary simplicity. The iconic curves endow the Picnik table with incredible strength and comfort and allow the easy drainage of water.

This iconic Extremis design came to life when Dirk Wynants sought to make a picnic table from a standard 1.5m x 1.5m sheet of aluminium, with as little material waste as possible. The shape is unbelievably strong due to strategic incisions and bends of exactly the right curvature. Dirk joined forces with Xavier Lust, a designer and artist known for his aluminium bending technique. Together, they finalised the design.



The rounded surfaces lend structural strength and stability to the form. Multiple tables can be stacked for transport or storage, thanks to the steeply sloping legs. The powder coated finish results in an exceptionally low maintenance picnic table for use indoors or outdoors. The simple design blends in effortlessly, yet gives the piece subtle presence. You could consider it as a piece of art you can sit at!


Construction

The Picnik is manufactured from a solid 1.5m x 1.5m aluminium sheet that is cut and bent into the correct shape, without creating any waste.

Materials info

Picnik consists entirely of structured powder coated aluminium. Powder coating is a technique in which a powder coating is applied dry to a surface. The powder coating is electrostatically charged and sprayed onto the item. The item is then placed in a hot oven where the powder melts to create an even film. A structured powder coating is sufficiently scratch-resistant and therefore ideal for intensive use.

Maintenance

Clean regularly with lukewarm water and a mild cleaning detergent. Absolutely do not use any aggressive products or scouring sponges. If necessary, use a soft brush to remove any caked-on dirt. Still dirty? Try a wonder sponge. Dip the wonder sponge evenly in water. Wipe the sponge over the spot. It works like an eraser. Don't rub too hard or for too long as this can cause matt spots. Our wonder sponge is the last resort, the spot must have disappeared by now!
