Warnings

General

- Do not use any sharp tools to open the packaging.
- We strongly advise against using power tools.
- Tripping hazard, mind your step.
- Do not put out cigarettes on the bench.
- Not grafitti proof.
- Do not leave children unattended whilst playing on the table.
- To avoid danger of suffocation, keep plastic bags away from babies and children.
- Colors can differ over years and from batch to batch.

Product

- Do not drag the table, but carry it with minimum 2 people.
- Do not sit or stand on the table.
- Always place the table on an even surface.
- Make sure the legs are always fully open.

Powder coating

- White powder coating requires more maintenance.
- Do not use abrasive scouring powders or scourers as they will scratch the surface.
- Color can fade to some extent when exposed to UV.
- Flame retarding NEN-EN13501-1 A2-sl Satisfying the same criteria as Class B for the SBI-test according to EN13823. In addition, under conditions of a fully developed fire these products will nog significantly contribute to the fire load and fire growth.
- Dark colors can get very hot in sunny weather.

Assembly text instructions



Take a look at the drawings, starting from page 8

Tiki table small (p8)

- 1. Unlock the locking system by pushing it upwards and open the frame.
- 2. Now lock the frame by pushing the locking system down.
- 3. Slide the tabletop over two caps.
- 4. Finally push the other cap(s) to fit the tabletop. Release the cap once the tabletop is in position so that the tabletop is fixed.

Disassembly Tiki table small (p12)

- 1. Push one black cap and lift the tabletop.
- 2. Slide the tabletop off the other two caps.
- 3. Unlock the frame by pushing the locking system upwards.
- 4. Finally fold the frame and lock the locking system by pushing it down.

Tiki table large (p16)

- 1. Unlock the locking system by pushing it upwards and open the frame.
- 2. Now lock the frame by pushing the locking system down.
- 3. Slide the tabletop over two caps.
- 4. Finally push the other cap(s) to fit the tabletop. Release the cap once the tabletop is in position so that the tabletop is fixed.

Disassembly Tiki table large (p20)

1. Push one black cap, lift the tabletop and release the cap.



- 2. Do the same for the black cap next to the first one.
- 3. Slide the tabletop off the remaining caps.
- 4. Unlock the frame by pushing the locking system upwards.
- 5. Finally fold the frame and lock the locking system by pushing it down.

Tiki table trolley (p24)

- Put the base frame upside down and attach all wheels with four M8x20 bolts each. <u>Attention</u>: make sure the swivel wheels are on the same side.
- 2. Now slide the four large tubes through the bottom of the base frame and fix these with four M8x20 bolts each.
- Position the top plate on top of the large tubes and fix it with four M6x40 bolts. Attention: make sure the Extremis logo is positioned on the side of the swivel wheels.
- 4. Then adhere the two tabletop protection plates to the middle of the frame (where the rods should go).
- Finally, insert the rods one by one into the base frame and top plate. <u>Tip</u>: first position the rod in the hole of the base frame, then bend it slightly to insert it into the top plate.

CLEANING

<u>Regularly</u>

Use Extremis Multicleaner, a 100% biodegradable detergent or common kitchen cleaning products. Avoid using aggressive products. These surfaces are best cleaned with a neutral cleaning product diluted in water.

REPAIRING DAMAGED POWDER COATING

When damaged

The impact of sharp objects can damage the coating. Scratches or dents can be touched up with our paint pens. However this only camouflages the scratches without removing them.

Galvanized steel

CLEANING <u>When dirty</u> Clean with lukewarm water and a brush.

REPARING DAMAGED PARTS WITH ZINC SPRAY When damaged

Hot dip galvanization is the most durable way of protecting metal against rusting. If the zinc coating is damaged, the exposed metal can



rust. This can easily be touched up with zinc paint that automatically has the same colour and is readily available in shops. Zinc spray forms a quick drying, self healing and flexible coating that helps stop corrosion.
